Program Goals

Our staff will provide special tools to assist in the success of the program, including educational materials and specialized equipment as necessary. Education will include lung disease education, proper medication usage and breathing retraining. According to the American Lung Association, COPD is the third leading cause of death in the United States. COPD and other pulmonary disorders are often preventable and treatable. Our Pulmonary Rehab Program consists of an individualized interdisciplinary rehabilitation program designed to maximize the functional ability of those with pulmonary disorders.
